The Historic Plaque Program offers the opportunity for owners of local historic homes within the Old Town Brunswick Historic District to visually identify their homes. Brunswick was added to the National Register of Historic Places on April 26, 1979. The historic district includes the site of the colonial British town of Brunswick, named after the family of King George III of Great Britain. **Plaque Description:** The plaque is hand-cast bronze from Erie Landmark Company and will be an 8” circle. The Coat of Arms for the Colonial King and members of the House of Hanover which gave rise to the street name will be on a raised seal in the center (no color). The background will be brown. The name & date of the original builder or early owner will be on the outer circle. The inner circle will have Historic Old Town Brunswick 1771(see example). The cost of the plaque is \$240.00. *Two mounting options are offered – wood or masonry.* Placement is up to the owner but it should be seen from the street. **NOTE: A matching Grant opportunity, offered by Magnolia Garden Club, is available for this program (info included).**
